The Virginia Social Science Association (VSSA), the oldest association of academics in Virginia, welcomes abstracts for proposed paper presentations from faculty members, graduate students, and undergraduates at our virtual 97<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference hosted by Sweet Briar College on Saturday, April 20, 2024. To be considered for inclusion in the program, please submit your abstract by 11:59 pm on Wednesday, March 20, 2024. In addition to an abstract, the proposal should include the following information: name, paper title, e-mail address, phone number, school name, academic status (undergraduate, graduate, faculty member), and if appropriate, the faculty advisor's name and contact information. The abstract should be no more than one page in length and should summarize the theoretical argument, methodology, findings, and significance of the project.

The VSSA conference is an ideal venue to present and get feedback on work in progress. The VSSA does not require faculty members or students to have completed papers for the conference.

**Student paper awards:** Faculty members are urged to encourage their graduate and undergraduate students to submit full papers for the "Best Paper" Competitions. Papers will only be considered if the abstract is accepted for the program and the student is presenting the paper at the conference. The deadline for submitting the full paper for the competition is <a href="https://doi.org/11.59.pm">11:59.pm</a> on March 20, 2024. VSSA will award \$500 to the winner of the graduate student paper award and \$250 to the winner of the undergraduate student paper award. Winners will be announced at the conference.

The paper requirements for award consideration are:

- (1) Maximum length (text and references): 25 standard double-spaced pages.
- (2) Letter or email of endorsement from a faculty member sent to Dr. Keith Kline at klineka@ymi.edu.
- (3) Cover page that includes the following information: name of author, title of paper, college or university, graduate or undergraduate student, year in school, major, phone number, email address, mailing address, name and email address of the faculty member endorsing the paper.
- (4) Papers and letters or emails of support must be received via email by 11:59 pm, on Wednesday, March 20, 2024.
